After investigation, the enforcement agency has found there is a reason to believe that Respondent (the person or entity named on this summons) has violated the following section of Title 24, Chapter 1, of the New York City Administrative Code (Air Pollution Control Code):

DESCRIPTION OF VIOLATION: Respondent caused or permitted the use of fuel burning equipment without first obtaining a Certificate of Operation from the DEP. Observed (1) Rockmills MP-125 Boiler with (1) Industrial Combustion DEG-54P Burner in use and in operation on the premises using Natural Gas and capable of using Grade 2 Fuel Oil. As per inspection and DEP CATS records, Certificate of Operation Application # CB067509 expired 09/15/2021 and renewal application was disapproved on 02/14/2024.

Infraction Code	Infraction Description
§ 24-122(b)(1)	No person shall cause or permit the use or operation of the following equipment, or cause or permit the keeping of any such equipment so as to be capable of being used or operated, without first obtaining a certificate of operation from the commissioner. Fuel burning equipment. - 1st offense

EQUIPMENT / APPARATUS IN VIOLATION: (1) Rockmills MP-125 Boiler with (1) Industrial Combustion DEG-54P Burner (5.25 million Btu/Hr.)
